Command Vehicle Upfitting December 15, 2024

The Ozark Fire Protection District is accepting sealed bid proposals through January 22, 2025, at 12:00 pm (CST) for upfitting services of a command vehicle. Sealed Proposal Submission Deadline No Later than 12:00p.m. CST, Wednesday, January 22nd, 2025. Open of bids will be done at the district headquarters at 12:30p.m. CST.

I. Request for Proposal

- Proposals are now being accepted by the Ozark Fire Protection District (OFPD) for the purchase and installation of a slide-out command center and components for the bed of an existing 2019 Ford F350.
- Obtaining a Request for Proposal:

II. Desired Equipment:

- The qualifying equipment and installation must meet the following criteria to be considered in the bidding process:
- Command Center should be similar to Extended Command Center Slide-Out Model “Yuba”
- Removal of existing drawers and lowering of existing slide-out.
- New command center will include:
 - Storage for battalion chief turn-out gear and SCBA
 - Storage for a 20lb. Dry-chem Fire Extinguisher and a 2.5gallon Pressurized Water Extinguisher
 - Electronics to include:
 - a. Installation/relocation of two mobile radios (existing)
 - b. Minimum 12.9” Ipad mount and power supply
 - c. External radio antennas and repeater
 - d. Radios/command boards to be on curb (right) side and/or rear of system.
 - Storage space for existing tools and equipment:
 - a. Four collapsible traffic cones
 - b. Thermal camera
 - c. Spare firefighting gloves, hoods, and traffic vests.
 - d. Drone storage case.
 - e. One blank magnetic dry-erase board and one formatted incident command/accountability magnetic dry-erase board.
 - f. Lighting for command boards

III. Policy On Nondiscrimination on the Basis of Disability

- In accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and Section 504 of

the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, the OFPD does not discriminate on the basis of disability in the admission of or access to, or treatment or employment in, its programs, activities, or services.

IV. Conflict of Interest

- A member or delegate to the Congress of the United States, or the Missouri General Assembly, or a member, elected official, officer or employee of the Ozark Fire Protection District, or a member, elected official, officer, or employee of a public body will only be authorized to receive an award of, and to perform this contract, upon full compliance with Sections 105.450 – 105.498 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri.
- Elected or appointed local, county and state governmental officials in the State of Missouri who are employees, officers, shareholders, or owners of a firm may participate in the award of, or performance of, this agreement, if:
 - The subcontract or purchase agreement is made pursuant to an award made after disclosure by the governmental official of the nature of the interest. The award is made in full compliance with Sections 105.450-105.498 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri. Pursuant to approval of the Ozark Fire Protection District.

V. Supplemental Information

- The awarded vendor shall provide one hour of time for a pre-construction meeting with the district's representative to ensure proper location and function of the installed equipment.
- The OFPD reserves the right to reject any and all bid proposals.
- Delivery is expected to be within two (2) months of awarding the bid.
- Contractor shall exonerate, indemnify, and hold harmless the OFPD, its agents and employees from and against all claims, damages, actions, losses, and expenses, including attorney fees, arising out of any negligent act or omission arising out of the performance of the services provided under such agreement.
- Contractor hereby agrees to furnish items and/or services described in this document and attachments, even if only by reference, pursuant to all requirements and specifications contained herein, and further agrees that the language of this document shall govern in the event of a conflict with his or her proposal.
