General Conditions of Permit

The 2018 International Fire Code, with the following provisions, shall mandate the following requirements regarding Mobile Food Vending, in accordance with NFPA 1 and Annex Bin NFPA 96:

1. Trash and combustible materials shall not accumulate and be located within 3 feet of the fuel supply.
2. A minimum of one (1) fire extinguisher, 2-A:20 B-C, shall be provided and K Class Fire Extinguisher.
3. Fuel sources shall be secured in accordance with NFPA.
4. Shall not block or obstructed access to a fire hydrant or within a fire lane.

LIST OF THE OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS CAN BE FOUND ON THE BACK.

Any change, modification, or addition from the conditions of this permit must be reviewed for modifications and impact upon the conditions of the Mobile Food Vendor Permit.

Possession of this permit does not exclude a Mobile Food Vendor from an inspection each time the business is set up within the boundaries of the District

This permit must be clearly posted in conspicuous place, or as mandated by a Fire Code Official, and available upon request.

Failure to comply with the provisions of this permit, or when a violation is found by inspection, will result in revocation of this permit and/or issuance of a citation.

FOOD TRUCK OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Provide appropriate waste receptacles at the site of the unit and remove all litter, debris and other waste attributable to the vendor on a daily basis.
2. Shall not be parked, situated or operated in a manner than restricts or blocks emergency vehicle apparatus access.
3. Shall not be parked, situated or operated in a manner than restricts or blocks fire hydrants, fire lanes or other fire protection equipment or access.
4. Comply with the City of Ozark (and/or) Christian County Noise Ordinance, Sign Ordinance and any other applicable ordinances.
5. Comply with all applicable federal, state and county regulations.
6. Not represent the granting of a permit under this chapter as an endorsement by the Ozark Fire District
7. Cooking operations in which grease laden vapors are or can be created, shall be provided with a Type I hood and fire suppression system.
8. Fire suppression system shall be inspected by a licensed company every six months.
9. **A minimum of 1 K- Class fire extinguisher shall be provided (when applicable).**
10. **A minimum of 1 2A-10BC fire extinguisher shall be provided.**
11. Propane cylinders shall be secured to the vehicle and installed in accordance with NFPA 58.
12. All temporary electrical shall comply with the provisions of this code and any other applicable city ordinances, county regulations or other applicable codes.
